

FAQ for Medical Appeals:

How do I file an appeal?

A request for an appeal must be in writing; state in clear and concise terms the reason or reasons
for disputing the denial, and be accompanied by any pertinent documentary material not already
furnished to the plan.

Where do I file my appeal?

• First & Second level appeals should be filed to:

How long do I have to file an appeal?

- Initial level of appeal (Internal Review), must be filed with the *plan administrator* within 180 days after receipt of the claim denial. If *your* request for review is not received within 180 days, *your* right to appeal the claim denial is forfeited.
- Second level of appeal (Internal Review), must be filed with the *plan administrator* for an appeal within 60 days after *your* receipt of an initial level appeal denial.
- Third level of appeal (Federal External Review), all requests for an independent review must be made within four (4) months of the date *you* receive the adverse benefit determination

What is a Federal External Review?

• The external review program offers an independent review process to review the denial of a requested service or procedure (other than a predetermination of benefits) or the denial of payment for a service or procedure.

What is the turnaround time on an appeal?

- First Level Appeals
 - For urgent care claims, within 72 hours or as soon as possible if your condition requires a shorter time frame (deference will be given to the medical provider as to what is urgent);
 - o For *pre-service claims*, within 15 days or as soon as possible if *your* condition requires a shorter time frame; or
 - o For post-service claims, within 30 days.
- Second Level Appeals
 - o 30 days after receipt of the request for the appeal, unless special circumstances require an extension of time for processing.
- Third Level of Appeals
 - o A decision will be made within 45 days of the receipt of the appeal.
